ORDINANCE NO. 004, Series of 2012

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF STO. TOMAS NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TO CAMALIGAN NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Local School Board, through its Board Resolution No. 004, unanimously proposed for changing the present name of Sto. Tomas National High School to Camaligan National High School;

WHEREAS, the present name of Sto. Tomas National High School has created confusion to its present status considering that there are names of other institutions bearing the name of Sto. Tomas in the various parts of the country;

WHEREAS, the location of the said institution is situated in two barangays: namely, San Lucas and San Jose-San Pablo, creating jealousy to the aforementioned barangays claiming for the said jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991 (RA 7160) under section 99-d provides that the Municipal School Board has the right to recommend the change in the name of public schools within the territorial jurisdiction of the local government unit for enactment by the Sangguniang Bayan concerned;

WHEREAS, Dep-Ed Order No. 29, series of 2011 entitled Revised Guidelines on the naming and renaming of schools, Roman No. III, No. 9 states that the name of schools, streets, hospitals, etc., which has been sanctified by usage by the residents of the community should be placed underneath the new name in the signage to facilitate the delivery of postal matter and serve as direct guide for people accustomed to the former name;

WHEREAS, schools, hospitals and other public structures named after the province or municipality are considered appropriately named, thus, naming the school to Camaligan, is appropriate,

WHEREAS, Section 13, letter c, No. 3 of the Local Government Code of 1991 (RA 7160) also provides that the Sanggunian of the component cities and municipalities may in consultation with the National Historical Institute may change the name of the City and Municipal Public Elementary, Secondary and Vocational or Technical Schools, Post Secondary and other Tertiary Schools;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion by Hon. Alfredo A. Azutillo, Sr., and duly seconded by all members present,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Camaligan, Camarines Sur that;

Section 1 – Title and scope – This ordinance shall be known as “ An Ordinance Changing the name of Sto. Tomas National High School to Camaligan National High School”.

The school shall be named “Camaligan National High School, formerly Sto Tomas National High School.

Section 2 - Location (Official Address) – The location and official address of the Camaligan National High School is San Jose-San Pablo, Camaligan, Camarines Sur;

Section 3 -Approval and Review - This ordinance shall be submitted to the National Historical Commission of the Philippines within 90 days after approval,

Section 4 - Separability Clause – if any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of the ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance which shall continue to be enforced and in effect.

Section 5 – Repealing Clause - Ordinances, Rules and Regulations or parts thereof, which are inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed and/or modified accordingly.

Section 6 - EFFECTIVITY DATE – This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.
