MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE # 07
Series of 2011

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 004-009 ESTABLISHING VOLUNTARY BLOOD DONATION PROGRAM IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF CAMALIGAN, CAMARINES SUR, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, the local government of Camaligan continues to promote voluntary blood donation among the constituency in compliance with RA 7719 or the Blood Services Act of 1994, and in furtherance of Municipal Ordinance No. 004-009;

WHEREAS, certain provisions therein are no longer relevant and have to be changed;

WHEREAS, the promulgation of the amended provisions shall carry out more effectively the continuance of this significant health program;

WHEREFORE, on motion by Councilor Shiela A. Morico duly seconded by Councilor Josefina N. Asor;

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Camaligan, Camarines Sur, that:-

SECTION 1. Title – This ordinance shall now be called “**KADUGO ASIN KADAMAY NINDO ORDINANCE OF CAMALIGAN, CAMARINES SUR**”.

SECTION 2. Section 7 of Article II of the Ordinance sets the composition of the Municipal Blood Council, to be appointed by the Municipal Mayor through an Executive Order, as follows:

Section 7. The Local Blood Council - The Municipal Blood Council is hereby created which shall be composed of the following and with members to be appointed by the Municipal Mayor, as Chairman, through an Executive Order

- (1) Representative from the Municipal Health Office;
- (2) Representative from the Sanggunian

- (3) Representative from the Social Welfare Office;
- (4) Representative from the academe;
- (5) Two (2) representative from other Line Agencies of the Government;
- (6) Representative from the Liga ng mga Barangay
- (7) Representative from the Sangguniang Kabataan;
- (8) Representative from the Camaligan Barangay Kagawad Association
- (9) Representative from Parokya ni Nô Movement
- (10) Three (3) representatives from the NGO's/PO's

SECTION 3. Section 7 shall now read:

- (1) Representative from the Municipal Health Office;
- (2) Chairperson, SB Committee on Health
- (3) Representative from the Social Welfare Office;
- (4) Public Schools District Supervisor;
- (5) Representatives from the DILG and PNP;
- (6) Representative from the Liga ng mga Barangay
- (7) Representative from the Sangguniang Kabataan;
- (8) Representatives of the Women, Senior Citizen, and PWD Sectors

SECTION 4. Section 8 of the Ordinance reads **The Program Director** – Overall operation of the program shall still be under the Parokya ni Nô Movement who shall select from among themselves the “Dugo Mo Buhay Ko Program Director. For added credibility to the program, the Program Director shall ideally be a regular volunteer blood donor himself or herself, and an active advocate of the blood program.

SECTION 5. Section 8 shall now read: **The Program Director** – Overall operation of the program be under the Office of the Mayor which shall designate a Program director. For added credibility to the program, the Program Director shall ideally be a regular volunteer blood donor himself or herself, and an active advocate of the blood program.

The Program Director shall have the following functions:-

- (1) Maintain constant communication and functional relationship with partner agencies – the Bicol Medical Center, the Philippine National Red Cross and other hospitals on matters relating to blood donation and transfusion;
- (2) Coordinate with the different barangay councils, through their Health Committee, other Barangay Volunteer Workers, private entities, Schools, NGO's/PO's/Civic groups in the mobilization of prospective blood donors and the campaign on blood donors advocacy;
- (3) Encourage participation, as actual blood donors or campaign propagators, from the municipal officials and employees and all personnel of various line agencies;
- (4) Coordinate with concerned departments regarding funding requirements in the operation of the program;
- (5) Maintain registry of Blood Donors and their vital records and the list of program supporters. Copies of which shall be provided also to the Municipal Blood Council and the Municipal Health Office. If available, records of their contact numbers and address, blood type must also be kept. A separate listing of people with special or rare types of blood (e.g. those with type AB blood, or those with RH Negative, etc.), together with their addresses and

contact numbers, shall be established in the entire municipality, to facilitate coordination and assistance during emergency cases.

(6) Regularly report to the Local Chief Executive and the Local Blood Council the operational status of the program;

SECTION 6. Repealing Clause. All ordinances, rules, orders, and regulations or parts thereof contrary to or inconsistent with any of the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed;

SECTION 7. Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect in full and immediately upon its approval.
