AN ORDINANCE FURTHER AMENDING SECTION 64 PAR. (1) OF MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE # 012-008, KNOWN AS THE TRANSPORT AND TRAFFIC CODE OF CAMALIGAN, CAMARINES SUR, AS AMENDED BY MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE 003-009 OPENING FIVE (5) ADDITIONAL FRANCHISES EACH FOR SJSRPODA AND SMSTPODA PUBLIC UTILITY PADJAKS

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Sangguniang Bayan of Camaligan, Camarines Sur that:-

**SECTION 1.** Section 64 of Municipal Ordinance 012-008 as amended by Municipal Ordinance # 003-009 allows the following number of padjaks units to operate in the municipality :-

**“SECTION 64 –Limitation and Area of Operation.** Every pedaled/motorized padjak intended “For Hire” operation shall, prior to registration, apply for membership at accredited padjak association, governed by the following conditions.

- 1.) Each association shall have a limited number of members which shall be restricted to ply on specific routes hereunder stipulated:-

**SECTION 4. Separability Clause.** If any provision of this code, or the application thereon to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the code, and the application of such provision, and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby;

**SECTION 5. Effectivity.** This ordinance shall take effect in full and immediately upon its approval, unless otherwise suspended by the proper authorities.
