MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE # 002
Series of 2011

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE # 012-08, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE 2008 REVISED TRANSPORT AND TRAFFIC CODE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CAMALIGAN, CAMARINES SUR PARTICULARLY ARTICLE VI SECTION 75 THEREOF, PERTAINING TO AUTHORIZED PASSENGER FARES FOR DUGCAL-SUA TRIMOBILE UNITS TRIMOBILE OPERATORS AND DRIVERS ADJUSTING THE SAME FROM SIX PESOS (Php 6.00) TO SEVEN PESOS (PHP 7.00) FOR THE FIRST TWO (2) KILOMETERS.

WHEREAS, in view of the increasing cost of Public Utility business operations and vehicle maintenance brought by uncontrolled prices of fuel and its by-products, and the soaring prices of commodities, the DUGCAL-SUA TRICYCLE OPERATORS AND DRIVERS' ASSOCIATION (DSTODA), through a resolution, petitioned for an increase in the authorized fare as embodied in the 2008 Revised Transport and Traffic Code;

WHEREAS, there has been no fare increase since the grant of franchise to the members;

WHEREAS, in the review of the petition, this body deemed it necessary to consider the interest of all the concerned sectors and found the same feasible and justifiable hence this action;

WHEREFORE, on motion by Councilor Jose O. Agomaa, Jr. duly seconded by Councilor Josefina N. Asor,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Camaligan, Camarines Sur, that:-

SECTION 1. Section 75, Article V of the 2008 Revised Transport and Traffic Code is now further amended to read as follows:

SECTION 75 – Fares. Any owner/operator of motor / motorized padjak shall be allowed to collect fares per passenger under the following schedule of rate:

- 1) Seven pesos (Php 7.00) for the first two kilometers;
- 2) One peso (Php 1.00) for the succeeding kilometer or fraction thereof.

The demand or collection of the so-called ‘double ride’ and or excessive rate within the two (2) kilometer distance from any point of embarkation within the municipality is strictly prohibited;

The applicable laws on fare discounts of students, senior citizens, and disabled persons shall apply accordingly.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after its approval within which information dissemination shall have been widely conducted, including the posting of this ordinance at conspicuous places in the thirteen barangays of the municipality.
