MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 020
Series 2020

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FIFTY THOUSAND PESOS (Php: 50,000.00) FOR EACH FILIPINO RESIDENT OF CAMALIGAN CAMARINES SUR WHO HAS REACHED ONE HUNDRED YEARS OLD AND OLDER.

WHEREAS: Republic Act 10868 enacted into law last June 30, 2016 provides that all Filipino who reach the age of one hundred years shall be honored with (a) a letter of Felicitation from the President of the Philippines congratulating the celebrant for longevity and (b) a Centenarian Gift in the amount of one hundred thousand pesos (Php: 100,000.00).

WHEREAS: The same Act declares the First Sunday of October as the National Respect for Centenarians Day during which all Filipino who have turned centenarian during the current fiscal year shall be awarded a plaque of recognition and a cash incentive by their respective Municipal government in appropriate ceremonies in addition to the aforementioned benefits.

WHEREAS: The Act Further provides that the local government unit concerned shall determine the amount of the cash incentive.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Camaligan Camarines, Sur.,

SECTION 1. Title- This Ordinance shall be known as the Municipal Centenarians Incentive Ordinance.”

SECTION 2. Definition of terms; -

- * *CENTENARIAN* – a person who is one hundred or more years old
- * *NATIONAL RESPECT FOR CENTENARIAN 'S DAY*-as declared under Republic Act No. 10868 every 1st Sunday of October (or on the following Monday, the first official working day.)
- * *INCENTIVE* – A thing that motivates or encourages one to do Something.
-supplemental reward that serves as a motivational device
For a desired action or behavior

SECTION 3. CASH INCENTIVE AND RECOGNITION; -

- a. The amount of Fifty Thousand (Php: 50,000.00) shall be given by the local Government of Camaligan CAMARINES SUR., as a one-time incentive to each qualified each SENIOR CITIZEN on the occasion of his/her 100TH BIRTHDAY.
- b. A plaque of recognition shall also be awarded to him/her or his/her / daughter or nearest surviving relative, (son/daughter or brother/sister) in a appropriate ceremony on the National Respect for Centenarians day in October or any day in a month at the convenient of the recipient.
- c. Both the cash incentive and the plaque of recognition shall likewise be given to each living resident who turned one hundred years old and older prior to the enactment of the ordinance.



SECTION 4. DOCUMENTARY REQUIREMENTS; -

Before September 1 prior to the forthcoming Respect for the Centenarians Day or upon reaching the age of 100 yrs. Old at which the centenarian to be given the cash incentive, he/she or his/her representatives shall submit to the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office any government issued identification card or documents that establishes the centenarians:

- a. Senior Citizen identification card or/ any government issued card attesting his/her Filipino citizenship
- b. Birth certificate from National Statistic office or Municipal Registrar's office showing that he/she is 100 years old of age.
- c. Certification from Barangay Association of Senior Citizen (BASCA) certifying to his/her residency over at least 10 yrs.

The Head of the office of Office of Senior Citizens Affairs (OSCA) shall identify prospective centenarians and assist them and their families in the preparation and submission of the documentary requirements.

SECTION 5. Funding- The cash incentives shall be provided in the annual budget of the municipality.

SECTION 6. Effectivity- This Ordinance shall be effective upon approval.
